Request for Your Co-operation

The Employment Status Survey is a statistical inquiry aiming at revealing the employment characteristics of the population in Japan. The information obtained will be used as the basic data in formulating employment policies, analysing employment structure, etc. by governmental agencies as well as non-governmental.

This is a sample survey, which is statistically designed to enumerate a part of the total population. The selection of the population is made in terms of households on the basis of the statistical procedure. Your household is selected as one of the sample households.

You are earnestly requested to fill out this Household Schedule and the Individual Schedule which is separately distributed.

The statistical law, on which this survey is based, prohibits the use of the information supplied by you for purposes other than strictly statistical. It is also forbidden that enumerators and any other officials who may be engaged in the survey disclose what is reported in the schedules. You are, therefore, kindly requested to provide information frankly and accurately.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTES BEFORE FILLING OUT

- All members who usually live in your household are to be enumerated.

The term "usually live" means that your household members have lived or are going to live in your household for three months or more. Normally, your family members as well as live-in domestic servants are to be included unless they have been away from your household for more than three months owing to travelling or working elsewhere.

Attention should be directed to such persons as students living in a school dormitory, hospitalized patients, etc., who are to be enumerated at the following places.

- Students and pupils living in school dormitories At dormitories
- Hospitalized patients
 - If hospitalized for more than three months At hospitals
 - If hospitalized for less than three months At dwelling houses
- Crews of ships At dwelling houses

The following persons are excluded from the survey.

- All residents of camps and of ships belonging to the National Defence Forces
- Persons in prisons or detention houses whose penalties have been fixed, and persons in reformatories or woman's guidance homes

- This Household Schedule is to be completed for each household. Attention should be directed to such persons as lodgers and unmarried employees living in issued dormitories.
 - Boarders or roomers, if they are single, complete a Household Schedule for each person, and if they are married a Household Schedule for each family.
 - Persons living in school dormitories or issued dormitories for unmarried employees complete a Household Schedule for each person
- The survey schedules consist of this Household Schedule and the Individual Schedule. The latter is to be filled out for each person 15 years old and over, who is listed in the Household Schedule.
- In answering the questions, please use the "How to Fill out The Schedules" which is separately distributed.
- The enumerator will help you when he calls on you to collect the schedules if any questions arise as to the contents of the schedules.

The following columns are to be filled out by the head of household.

- List all members 15 years old and over (those who were born before 30 June 1956).
- Circle the most appropriate number in the case where the answer is given.
