## On The Housing Census

## How To Fill Out The Questionnaire

This questionnaire must be filled out separately for each household.

2 The parts which you must fill out are as follows.

For general households, the part "TO BE FILLED OUT BY HEAD OF HOUSEHOLD" on pages 2 and 3 should be filled out.


For persons living alone in apartments, the same parts above should be filled out.


For the following households, only the part on page 3 should be filled out.


- Households of boarders or lodgers, consisting of two or more family members
- Households of live-in business employees, consisting of two or more family members
- Households consisting of two or more family members living in dormitories

The following persons should be grouped together into a separate quasihousehold, for whom question numbers 13, 14, 15 and 24 should be filled out.

- O Lodgers living alone
- O Live-in business employees without families
- O Persons living in dormitories without families

# Notes on Filling Out the Questionnaire

#### Is this dwelling house owned or rented by your household?

 O "I Owned" means a dwelling house which is owned by the occupant household.

Include the dwelling house not yet legally registered or not yet completely paid for if purchased in installments.

- O Public corporation in "4 Rented-owned of public corporation" means Japan Housing Public Corporation, Housing Association, Developing Public Association, Housing Supply Public Association, etc.
- O "5 Issued" means dwelling houses provided by companies or government for their employees: including those rented by companies or employers and offered for the use of employees.

#### When was this dwelling house built?

 State the initial period of construction even though enlargements or repairs were later made.

## 4 (A) What kind is the water supply of this dwelling house?

 I Aqueduct" includes water that is pumped from a well into a tank and distributed to two or more dwelling houses through pipes.

#### How large is this dwelling house?

- Include in floor space those areas used for business, such as small shops, unfloored parts of farm houses, etc.
- Exclude storehouses, workshops, etc. in buildings detached from your dwelling house,
- O Convert tsubo into square metres, one tsubo being equal to 3.3 square metres,

#### Is this ground owned privately or rented?

- O Answer irrespective of legal registration.
- O "I owned" also includes the occupants of apartments who own the ground for the building in common.

## When and from whom was this ground purchased or rented? (B) From whom?

 State the actual owner from whom you purchased or rented the ground and not the agent who merely transacted the business.

# 1 (A) Since January 1964, have you enlarged your dwelling house for your household's use?

O Answer "2 No" if enlargement was made to accommodate other households.

# How many members does this household include ?

O Include those who happened to be away from home for a short period on or around October 1, but exclude temporary visitors and those household members who have been or will be away for a long period.

## 14 How many rooms does this dwelling house contain?

- Include in rooms, living rooms, bed rooms, drawing rooms, studies, etc.
- Include the above rooms even if in a detached building.
- Include dining-kitchen if it is equivalent to the space of three tatami or more with the exclusion of the sink.
- O Exclude entrance, kitchen, toilet, bath-room, passage, o etc.

Exclude rooms used for business, such as small shops, offices, unfloored parts of farm houses, etc.

#### 15 How many tatami do the above rooms contain?

Include all rooms included under question No.14 whether floored by tatami or not, converting in the later case at the ratio of one tatami per 1.65 square metres.

 Exclude the sink in converting the floor space of diningkitchen.

## 19 Is this person employed or self-employed?

- O Division chiefs, section chiefs and their equivalents should not be included in "4 Director of a company, public corporation, etc." but should be included in either "1" or "2" as the case may be.
- O "5 Self-employed" includes medical and law practitioners, writers, artists, etc. as well as unincorporated small shop or factory owners, farmers, etc.

## 20 What kind of work is this person engaged in?

O Describe in detail rather than simply stating employee of a company or civil servant.

Refer to the following examples

File clerk, printer, tofu making, watch repair, farmer, taxi driver, guard, retail dealer, lawyer, director of a company, chief of accounting section, etc.

## 21 How many minutes does this person take to commute from his house?

 State the total length of time spent in commuting, including walking and all transportation facilities usually employed; bus, train, etc.

## 22 When did this person move into the present living quarters ?

O State the time he first moved into the present residence even if it was later reconstructed.
